Background This item is a painted reproduction of a rare first edition Septriq: The Seventh Window software jacket cover artwork, thought to have been originally manufactured between 2002 and 2006. The antique jacket was donated to the St. Coriander Library by Dabney Fanneraq when she Elevated in 2139. Ms. Fanneraq was the prototypical Septriq fanatic in St. Coriander and is thought to be the first to use it as an oracle.

The rendition featured on the following page was programmed and painted in 2142 as a practice exercise by Iris Ho, president of St. Coriander's Faithful Replication Society during its low years immediately following the Lost Rembrandt Scandal of 2139. The painting became part of the St. Coriander Library's Special Archive some years later and thus this copy found its way into the Transpoint Independent Archive.



Original size of painting was 10" x 10". Original size of software sleeve is believed to have been approximately 5.25" x 5.25".
